3 **TITLE II—RECONCILIATION**

4 **SEC. 2001. RECONCILIATION IN THE HOUSE OF REP-**  
5 **RESENTATIVES.**

6 (a) COMMITTEE ON AGRICULTURE.—The Committee  
7 on Agriculture of the House of Representatives shall re-  
8 port changes in laws within its jurisdiction that reduce the  
9 deficit by not less than \$230,000,000,000 for the period  
10 of fiscal years 2025 through 2034.

1 (b) COMMITTEE ON ARMED SERVICES.—The Com-  
2 mittee on Armed Services of the House of Representatives  
3 shall report changes in laws within its jurisdiction that  
4 increase the deficit by not more than \$150,000,000,000  
5 for the period of fiscal years 2025 through 2034.

6 (c) COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION AND WORKFORCE.—  
7 The Committee on Education and Workforce of the House  
8 of Representatives shall report changes in laws within its  
9 jurisdiction that reduce the deficit by not less than  
10 \$330,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal years 2025  
11 through 2034.

12 (d) COMMITTEE ON ENERGY AND COMMERCE.—The  
13 Committee on Energy and Commerce of the House of  
14 Representatives shall report changes in laws within its ju-  
15 risdiction that reduce the deficit by not less than  
16 \$880,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal years 2025  
17 through 2034.

18 (e) COMMITTEE ON NATURAL RESOURCES.—The  
19 Committee on Natural Resources of the House of Rep-  
20 resentatives shall report changes in laws within its juris-  
21 diction that reduce the deficit by not less than  
22 \$1,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal years 2025  
23 through 2034.

24 (f) COMMITTEE ON HOMELAND SECURITY.—The  
25 Committee on Homeland Security of the House of Rep-

1 representatives shall report changes in laws within its juris-  
2 diction that increase the deficit by not more than  
3 \$175,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal years 2025  
4 through 2034.

5 (g) COMMITTEE ON THE JUDICIARY.—The Com-  
6 mittee on the Judiciary of the House of Representatives  
7 shall report changes in laws within its jurisdiction that  
8 increase the deficit by not more than \$175,000,000,000  
9 for the period of fiscal years 2025 through 2034.

10 (h) COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORTATION AND INFRA-  
11 STRUCTURE.—The Committee on Transportation and In-  
12 frastructure of the House of Representatives shall report  
13 changes in laws within its jurisdiction that reduce the def-  
14 icit by not less than \$10,000,000,000 for the period of  
15 fiscal years 2025 through 2034.

16 (i) COMMITTEE ON FINANCIAL SERVICES.—The  
17 Committee on Financial Services of the House of Rep-  
18 resentatives shall report changes in laws within its juris-  
19 diction that reduce the deficit by not less than  
20 \$1,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal years 2025  
21 through 2034.

22 (j) SUBMISSIONS.—In the House of Representatives,  
23 not later than March 7, 2025, the committees named in  
24 the subsections of this section shall submit their rec-

1 ommendations to the Committee on the Budget of the  
2 House of Representatives to carry out this section.

3 **SEC. 2002. RECONCILIATION IN THE SENATE.**

4 (a) COMMITTEE ON AGRICULTURE, NUTRITION, AND  
5 FORESTRY.—The Committee on Agriculture, Nutrition,  
6 and Forestry of the Senate shall report changes in laws  
7 within its jurisdiction that reduce the deficit by not less  
8 than \$230,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal years 2025  
9 through 2034.

10 (b) COMMITTEE ON ARMED SERVICES.—The Com-  
11 mittee on Armed Services of the Senate shall report  
12 changes in laws within its jurisdiction that increase the  
13 deficit by not more than \$150,000,000,000 for the period  
14 of fiscal years 2025 through 2034.

15 (c) COMMITTEE ON COMMITTEE ON BANKING, HOUS-  
16 ING, AND URBAN AFFAIRS.—The Committee on Banking,  
17 Housing, and Urban Affairs of the Senate shall report  
18 changes in laws within its jurisdiction that reduce the def-  
19 icit by not less than \$1,000,000,000 for the period of fis-  
20 cal years 2025 through 2034.

21 (d) COMMITTEE ON COMMERCE, SCIENCE, AND  
22 TRANSPORTATION.—The Committee on Commerce,  
23 Science, and Transportation of the Senate shall report  
24 changes in laws within its jurisdiction that reduce the def-

1 icit by not less than \$440,000,000,000 for the period of  
2 fiscal years 2025 through 2034.

3 (e) COMMITTEE ON ENERGY AND NATURAL RE-  
4 SOURCES.—The Committee on Energy and Natural Re-  
5 sources of the Senate shall report changes in laws within  
6 its jurisdiction that reduce the deficit by not less than  
7 \$440,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal years 2025  
8 through 2034.

9 (f) COMMITTEE ON ENVIRONMENT AND PUBLIC  
10 WORKS.—The Committee on Environment and Public  
11 Works of the Senate shall report changes in laws within  
12 its jurisdiction that increase the deficit by not more than  
13 \$1,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal years 2025  
14 through 2034.

15 (g) COMMITTEE ON FINANCE.—The Committee on  
16 Finance of the Senate shall report changes in laws within  
17 its jurisdiction that reduce the deficit by not less than  
18 \$1,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal years 2025  
19 through 2034.

20 (h) COMMITTEE ON HEALTH, EDUCATION, LABOR,  
21 AND PENSIONS.—The Committee on Health, Education,  
22 Labor, and Pensions of the Senate shall report changes  
23 in laws within its jurisdiction that reduce the deficit by  
24 not less than \$330,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal  
25 years 2025 through 2034.

1           (i) COMMITTEE ON HOMELAND SECURITY AND GOV-  
2   ERNMENTAL AFFAIRS.—The Committee on Homeland Se-  
3   curity and Governmental Affairs of the Senate shall report  
4   changes in laws within its jurisdiction that increase the  
5   deficit by not more than \$175,000,000,000 for the period  
6   of fiscal years 2025 through 2034.

7           (j) COMMITTEE ON THE JUDICIARY.—The Com-  
8   mittee on the Judiciary of the Senate shall report changes  
9   in laws within its jurisdiction that increase the deficit by  
10   not more than \$175,000,000,000 for the period of fiscal  
11   years 2025 through 2034.

12          (k) SUBMISSIONS.—In the Senate, not later than  
13   March 7, 2025, the committees named in the subsections  
14   of this section shall submit their recommendations to the  
15   Committee on the Budget of the Senate. Upon receiving  
16   all such recommendations, the Committee on the Budget  
17   of the Senate shall report to the Senate a reconciliation  
18   bill carrying out all such recommendations without any  
19   substantive revision.
