A BILL

To remove restrictions from a parcel of land in Paducah,
Kentucky.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REMOVAL OF RESTRICTION.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Interior shall
5 execute such instruments as may be necessary to remove
6 all deed restrictions from the parcel of land described in
7 subsection (c).

8 (b) DEED RESTRICTIONS.—The deed restrictions re-
9 ferred to in subsection (a) are those restrictions, including
10 easements, exceptions, reservations, terms, conditions, and

1 covenants described in the quitclaim deed from the United
2 States to the City of Paducah, Kentucky, executed on
3 April 27, 2012, and recorded by the Clerk of the County
4 Court of McCracken County, Kentucky on pages 247
5 through 260 of Deed Book 1229.

6 (c) LAND DESCRIPTION.—The parcel of land referred
7 to in subsection (a) is the parcel—

8 (1) comprised of approximately 3.62 acres lo-
9 cated at 2956 Park Avenue, on the Paducah Memo-
10 rial Army Reserve Center, Paducah, McCracken
11 County, Kentucky, including the improvements
12 thereon; and

13 (2) conveyed by the Secretary of the Interior to
14 the City of Paducah, Kentucky.
